For parents and students

Prepare to learn from home

Here's how you can prepare for remote learning from home or another space.

Set up a learning space at home

In your home or the place you are staying, you'll need a space that you feel comfortable to focus, learn and be in.

Ideally, you'll have a computer or laptop with a camera or webcam. This is not essential, but will provide you with a better learning experience. You might need your parents or carers to help you get set up.

Do you have internet access?

Most learning at home requires the internet. If you have a weak or limited connection, please contact Steve Leed and hard copy work will be organised.

The college has set out how work will be provided in our Frequently Asked Questions document.

Consider using a mobile data connection or contacting your service provider for a temporary economical solution.

Department and school resources

Now that you have sorted out the environment, here are the tools that can be used to support your learning at home:

Accessing Office 365 (Microsoft Teams and OneNote)

Most staff will have Microsoft Teams and OneNote on their computers already. If you cannot find these programs, please let Nick Marlow or Sarah Clare know. At this stage, we are prioritising getting staff onto Microsoft Teams so we can run meetings and collaborate.
